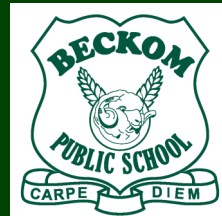


# Beckom Public School

## Excursion to Temora Rural Museum

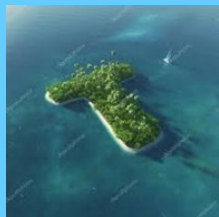

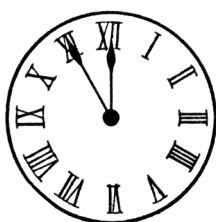
