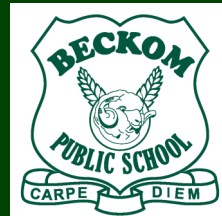

## Eddy the Elf returns to the school

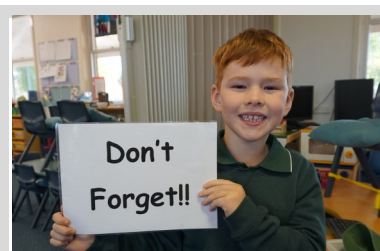
