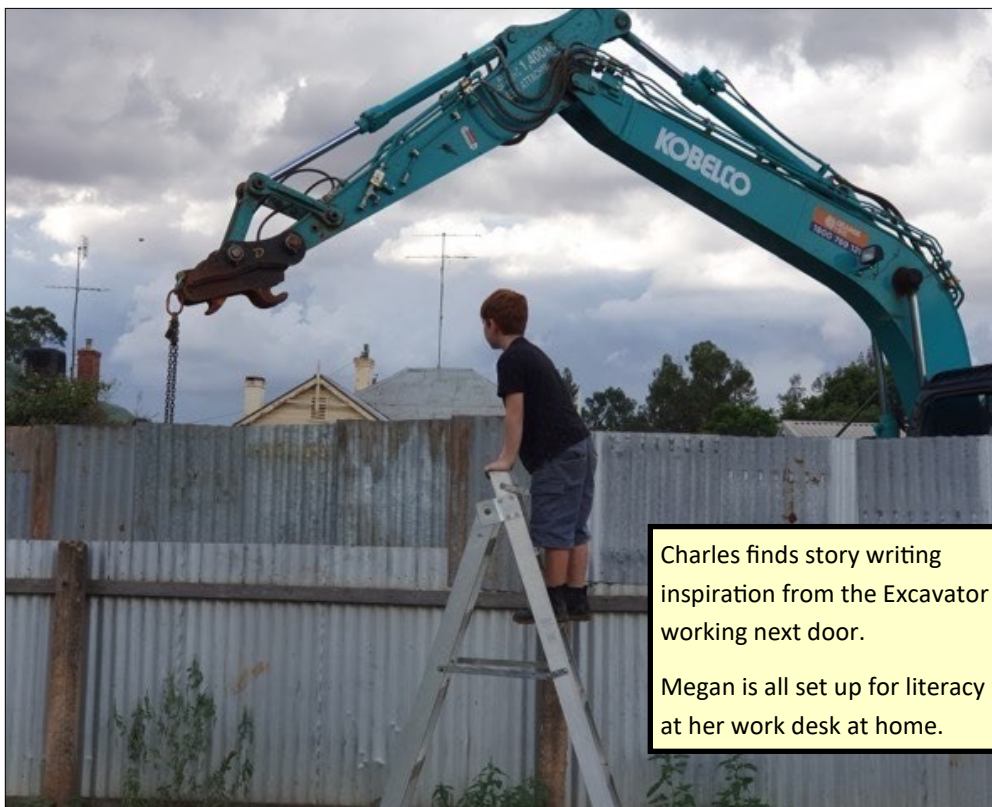
Miss Kent and I have been busy preparing student work packs for the start of Term 2. These work packs will be sent home prior to the end of term.

STUDENTS BEGIN LEARNING AT HOME



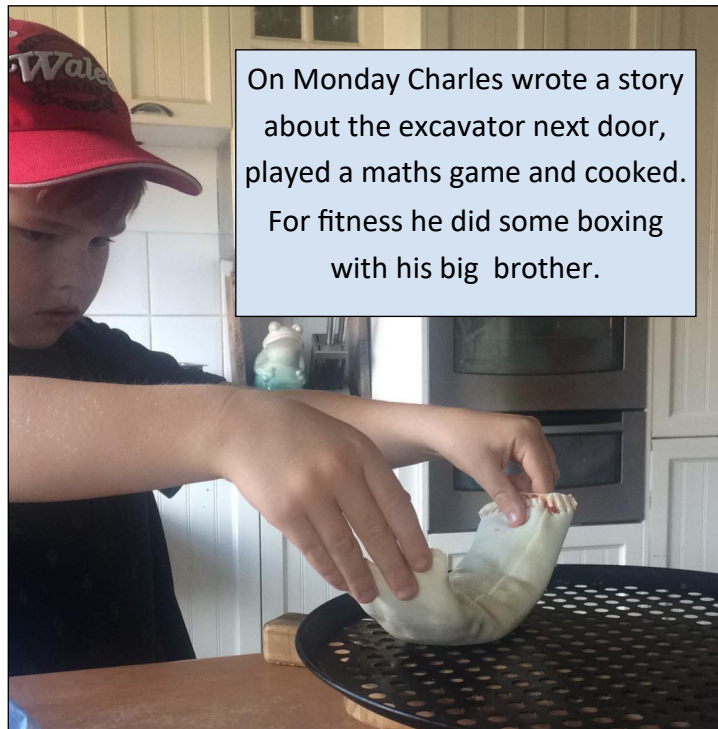
Charles finds story writing inspiration from the Excavator working next door.

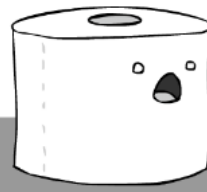


On Monday Charles wrote a story

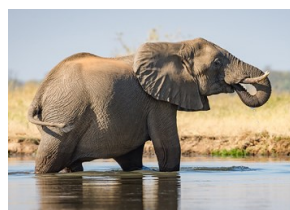


TRIVIA CORNER
