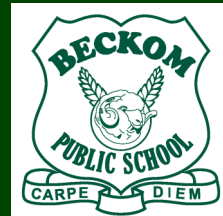

Please feel free to send in photos of what your child's learning looks like. We look forward to seeing the smiling faces of our students and some of these photos will be used in our newsletter.

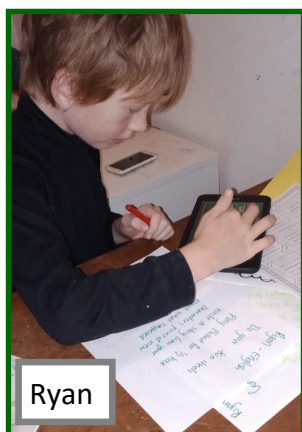
Our current learning environment is likely to continue into Term 2 therefore learning packs will be delivered to students at the beginning of Term 2 and then as needed throughout this time of home learning.

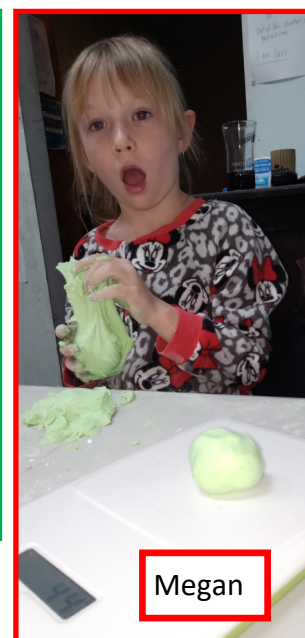

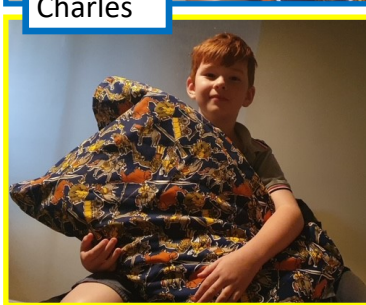

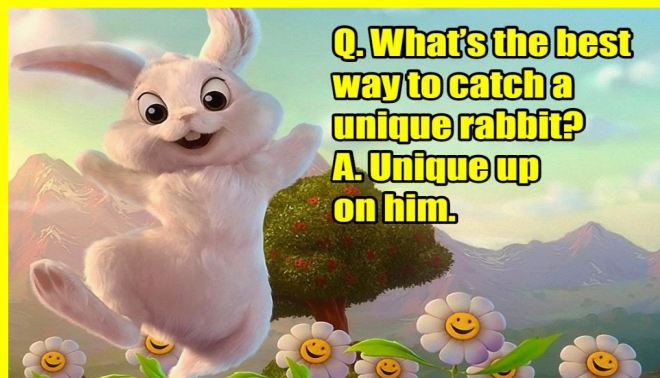
