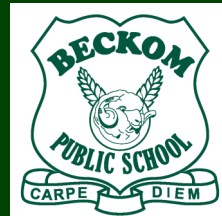


# Beckom Public School

These online learning sessions occur twice each day with the first one at 9:30am in the morning and the second one at 2:00pm in the afternoon. Thank you for being on time as this has ensured that our learning sessions run smoothly. Miss Kent and I have been working hard to try and set out activities to make learning from home as easy as possible for all students. If you have any concerns regarding the set activities please contact the school.

This term the NSW Education Department has given us guidelines to increase student attendance at school whilst also trying to ensure that students, staff and families remain free of the COVID-19 virus. The guidelines have different phases that we will work through. We are currently at Phase 0 and next week we will move into Phase 1. There are no set timelines for these phases, we just need to work on a week by week timetable until we are told when a phase is changing.

Next week (Week 3) students will be phased back to school on Tuesday 12th May for one day a week. Please ensure students bring in their borrowed computers (in their protective bags) and all of their learning so that teachers can complete updates and assist students with their learning. Please remember that students will not be able to use the kitchen or have food prepared for them during this time. Students will need to bring their fruit break and a packed lunchbox with all necessary cutlery.

Learning from home options will continue to be provided for the other four days of the week via remote learning packs and our online learning sessions using zoom meetings. These links are uploaded into the students' google classroom. Learning packs for Week 3 will be delivered tomorrow afternoon by staff. Please ensure your child's current pack is ready for collection and marking.

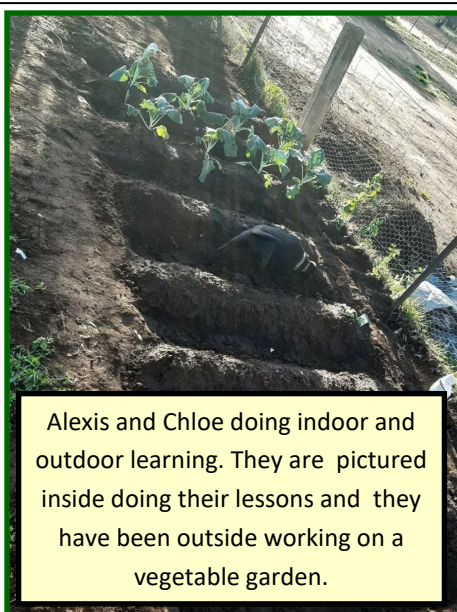
