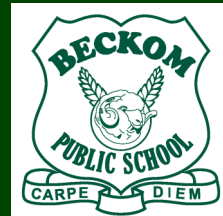

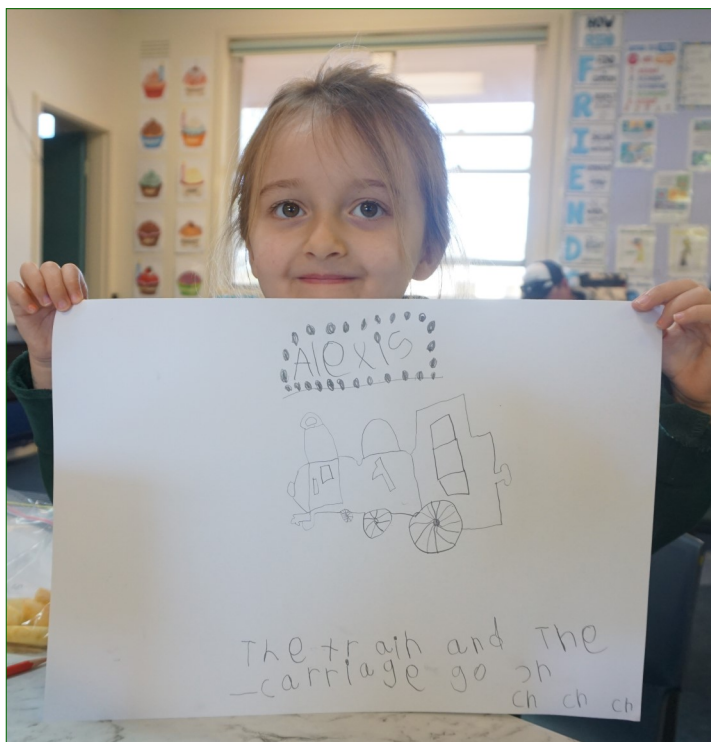
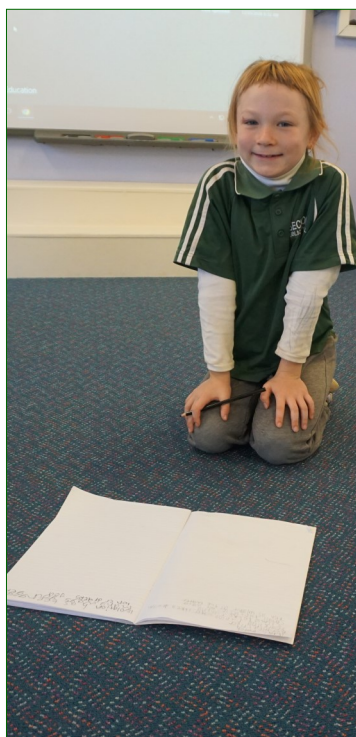

Good luck with this week's questions:-

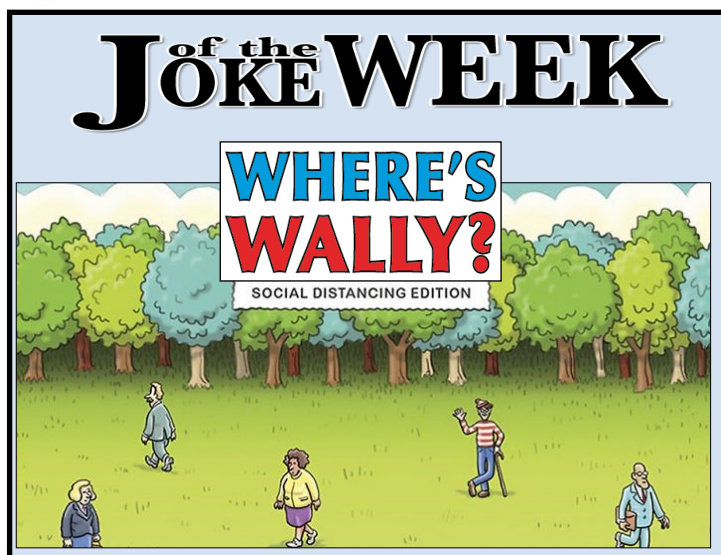
Adult question:

Coolamon



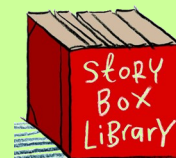
