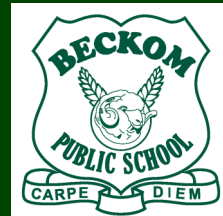

- Aim for 2 serves a day.

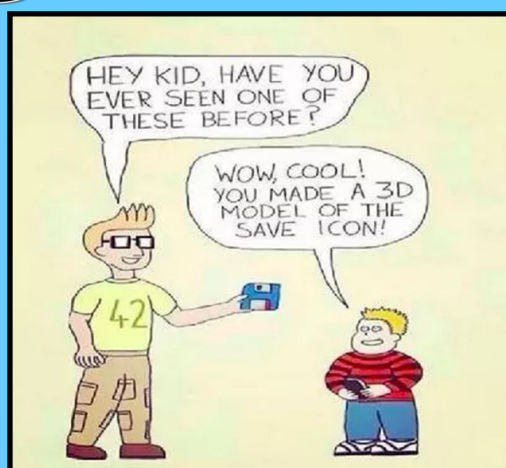

COMMUNITY NEWS

Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901

The Act provides a basis for taking action in relation to what is commonly referred to as "trespass". The Act provides for the following relevant offences:

- Entry without lawful excuse onto inclosed lands without the consent of the owner, occupier or person apparently in charge of the land.
- Remaining on inclosed lands after a request to leave is given by the owner, occupier or person apparently in charge of the land.
- Remaining on inclosed lands and behaving in an offensive manner after a request to leave is given by the owner, occupier or person apparently in charge of the land.
- Giving a false name and address after being requested to provide such details by the owner, occupier or person apparently in charge of the land.

When entering the school, all community members and visitors are required to access the school via the Front Office and sign in.

Outside of school hours, and during holiday periods, the property remains covered by the Inclosed Lands Protection Act.
